Royce H. Johnson, MD, Medical Director of the Valley Fever Institute was invited by House Majority Leader Congressman Kevin McCarthy to participate in a Roundtable Discussion about Valley Fever at the US Capitol.

Congressman Kevin McCarthy, Co-Chair of the Congressional Valley Fever Task Force, held a Valley Fever Roundtable with Members of Congress, leading researchers, patient advocates, doctors, and scientists from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and National Institutes of Health (NIH). McCarthy released the following statement:

"Today's roundtable was an excellent opportunity to bring together the brightest minds from around the country for an update on efforts to combat Valley Fever. This meeting also served as a chance to address the progress that has occurred and must continue in order to fight this disease.

"Doctors and scientists taking the lead are working diligently to develop a vaccine and I'm proud to report that an updated research study is being conducted by NIH, in partnership with Duke University, which will hopefully bring to light new solutions to stamp out Valley Fever.

"I want to thank Dr. Chiller (CDC) and Dr. Erbelding (National Institute



of Allergy and Infectious Diseases/ NIH) for their update on this progress. I'd also like to thank all of our illustrious panelists for being here with us today, including Dr. Royce Johnson who is leading the fight back home at Kern Medical and Rob Purdie who has been a passionate advocate at the Valley Fever Americas Foundation. Finally, thank you to Congressman Schweikert (AZ-06) for serving as Co-Chair of the Congressional Valley Fever Task Force and for working with me to bring more awareness to this issue on a federal level. Together we can continue building upon our successes while working to find new ways to stop this disease in its tracks."

Expanding the Valley Fever Institute will allow us to continue our mission to increase education & awareness for the public, patients and health care providers; provide the best pa-

tient care available and promote research that includes epidemiology, clinical drug development, prevention, immunology and immunizations.

# **OB/GYN SIMULATION LAB**

The OB/GYN Simulation Lab opened earlier this year with support from the Kern Medical Foundation. The lab

features two laproscopic simulators and an assortment of tools for our OB/GYN residents.





The purpose of this research study is to examine the rates at which the IUD stays in place immediately following delivery.

We are hoping to give patients contraception immediately after vaginal delivery or cesarean section and identify how many IUDs stay in place after delivery.

Patients will be monitored in hospital routinely for 1-3 days after vaginal delivery and then at their 6 week post delivery visit, the IUD will be checked to confirm its continued proper placement.







the UroLift procedure. UroLift is a minimally invasive BPH treatment. It is an outpatient procedure that uses tiny implants to hold open the obstructed pathway that is blocking during flow, addressing the blockage, not just continuously treating enlarged

prostate (BPH) symptoms. An earlier alternative to medical therapy that provides rapid relief and recovery of BPH symptoms. The UroLift is minimally invasive and offers better symptom relief than medication with a lower risk profile than TURP.

# EPILEPSY MONITORING UNIT



The National Association of Epilepsy Centers (NAEC) has accredited Kern Medical as a level 3 epilepsy center for 2019 and 2020. Accredited epilepsy centers provide a comprehensive program to diagnose and treat epilepsy with a patient-oriented team approach consisting of an epileptolgist (a neurologist with expertise in treating seizures), neurosurgeons, neuropsychologists, nurse specialists, EEG technologists, social workers, and others with training and experience in epilepsy care.

The Kern Medical Epilepsy Center is a member of the USC Epilepsy Care Consortium, a unique and unprecedented partnership comprised of six of the 21 NAEC-accredited epilepsy centers in California. The six centers in the USC Epilepsy Care Consortium span Orange, Los Angeles, Kern, and Madera Counties. Kern Medical is one of 239 accredited epilepsy centers in the country, and the only adult center between Los


Angeles and Sacramento.

"The USC Epilepsy Care Consortium was created to facilitate the development of epilepsy centers, and we are delighted that adult patients in Central California now have access to this important service," says Dr. Charles Liu, Surgical Director of the Kern Medical Epilepsy Center and Secretary of the USC Epilepsy Care Consortium.

"Our Center is solving many of the problems faced by the thousands of patients living in Central California who have limited access to epilepsy care," says Dr. Hari Veedu, Medical Director of the Kern Medical Epilepsy Center. "Whether it's challenges finding transportation to Southern California for care, long wait times to receive specialized treatment, provider issues with some insurance companies, or the long-term commitment needed for services hundreds of miles away, the Kern Medical Epilepsy Center is offering that relief."

Epilepsy is the fourth most common neurological problem, affecting more than 33,000 residents in Kern County. Nationwide epilepsy affects approximately 3 million adults and 500,000 children.
